Kingfisher Summer Term Curriculum Letter

Welcome back Kingfisher class! **Please check your emails and child's book bag daily for any letters and the website for our new curriculum information.** Both our teaching days remain the same, Mrs Inkpen on Mondays and Tuesdays and Mrs Leach Wednesday to Friday.

Reading

Children continue to have access to the Ebooks for Little Wandle Phonics. They will bring home a reading for pleasure book from the school library, which we are asking you to support your child with. Some of our year 2 children will now be accessing our library books instead of their phonics book. Every week on a **Thursday from 3:10-3:30pm** parents are welcome to come into school to read your child's book in the hall. We also ask that reading at home is recorded in their reading record book. These are checked every Monday.

PE

Our P.E sessions remain the same for this term on a Tuesday and a Friday. Children will continue to come in wearing their P.E kit on these days. We would appreciate your support in ensuring that your child has the appropriate **labelled** clothing for these lessons. P.E kit is: a white school P.E t-shirt/ or plain white, black shorts or black jogging bottoms, a school fleece or school jumper and trainers. Children are not to wear football kit or other sports clothing.

Year 2 SATs

This term we will be doing 'quizzes' with our year 2 pupils for reading and maths. These will be familiar to the children as they are already excellent at having a go in the hall. As previously mentioned these are no longer compulsory, however the Devon Moors Federation have decided to do them to help with making secure judgements of pupil progress within our setting. **As a reward for the children after each quiz, they will be allowed to enjoy a 'Maryland cookie'. Please could you let us know if your child has any allergies to these.**

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

In June, our year 1 pupils and some year 2 children will be completing the phonics screening check (PSC). Information about this has been shared with parents during our parent workshop and via email. If you have any questions, please come and see us. Mrs Inkpen will be carrying out the checks with individual children during the PSC week in June. The children are already familiar with this process.

As we are hopeful for some sunshine, please ensure your child has a **water bottle and a sun hat** every day. We ask that you apply **sun cream to your child before school.**

Finally, on Thursday 22nd May Kingfisher class will have a film and snack afternoon as part of the golden ticket rewards. Details of this event for our class will be confirmed nearer the time.
