Kestrel Summer Term Curriculum Letter 2026

Welcome back, Kestrel Class! I hope you all had a lovely Easter break!

Our P.E sessions continue to be on a Tuesday and Friday. Children will wear P.E kit all day on both of these days. P.E kit is: a white school P.E t-shirt/ or plain white, black shorts or black jogging bottoms, a school fleece or school jumper and trainers. Children are not to wear football kit or other sports clothing.

Also, please ensure that, as we enter the warmer months, your child has a water bottle, hat and sun cream, where appropriate.

Reading/Home learning:

Reading continues to be a focus across the school. Please encourage your child to read or be read to at home for approximately 20 minutes per day and sign their reading record book at least 3 times per week. The children are aware that they should have 2 reading books; a colour banded book which stays in school and an appropriately levelled 'reading for pleasure' book from the library to read at home.

Alongside daily reading, the children are encouraged to access online learning such as Maths Shed, Spelling Shed, timestables.co.uk and UR Brainy at home. Please ask for another copy of their logins if required.

MTC: At this point in the year, it is important that the Year 4s continue to work on consolidating their quick recall of multiplication facts up to 12x12, as they will be completing the **Multiplication Tables Check** in June. I will provide more information about this soon.

The summer term, as usual, is expected to be a busy one with the whole school trip (9th June), sports day (16th June) and summer performances (15/16th July), so please keep an eye on your emails for updates.
